IEG OBTAINS THE GBAC STAR™ SEAL FOR HYGIENE AND SAFETY STANDARDS

Italian Exhibition Group is now the first trade show and conference organizer in Italy to be accredited with the global cleaning and sanitizing protocol for its facilities at Rimini and Vicenza, alongside large international locations, such as Pittsburgh International Airport terminals, the Red Bull Arena in Harrison New Jersey and Kyoto International Conference Center.

Rimini/Vicenza, 21st April 2021 — A new tile in the safety mosaic, yet another certificate to ensure the health of exhibitors, visitors, employees and stakeholders. IEG - Italian Exhibition Group has completed the GBAC STAR™ accreditation process, the global certification program regarding the correct practices, procedures and systems to meet the international standards of cleanliness, disinfection and infectious disease prevention for facilities and staff promoted by the Global Biorisk Advisory Council (GBAC). An accreditation that sees IEG alongside internationally famous locations, including the terminals at Pittsburgh International Airport and the Red Bull Arena in Harrison, New Jersey, the home of the New York Red Bulls soccer team — a competitor in the MLS - and Kyoto International Conference Center.

The first Italian company to adhere to and activate – in July 2020 - a health safety accreditation process based on controllable and measurable scientific standards, IEG has achieved the objective by becoming the first Italian trade show and conference organizer to obtain this result and recognition, thus consolidating its daily commitment and the validity of the operations adopted at its administrative and operational headquarters at the Expo Centers in Rimini and Vicenza, at the Palacongressi Conference Center in Rimini and at VICC - Vicenza Convention Center.

"The GBAC STAR™ accreditation process began in the wake of the exceptional maneuvers inaugurated last year with the #Safebusiness by IEG protocol," – said Italian Exhibition Group's CEO, Corrado Peraboni. "A mission that targeted a precise direction: to guarantee all our public with vital health prevention levels throughout their visit. A commitment that those who participated in our trade show and conference events in Rimini and Vicenza between summer and autumn 2020 were well able to see. The measures and procedures put into practice guarantee extremely safe experiences from the point of view of health."

"GBAC STAR training has allowed us to implement cutting-edge and highly efficient sanitization systems and internal procedures," – said, Mario Vescovo, Director of Operations at IEG's Vicenza premises who coordinated the process. "This certification means that we can activate audit and control systems for training and responsibilizing management and employees, for cleaning and disposal procedures, for the use of the most suitable equipment, devices and products for each situation.
